#### TREASURER'S REPORT

- Ron was unable to attend the meeting; however, he provided Docia with the Treasury Report dated 11/13/09 – 1/19/10 and a copy of the check register. Checking balance is \$10,354.33.

#### OLD BUSINESS

- Soccer clinic – Coach Barclay requested \$300 from TAB to cover room and board expenses for the soccer clinic - \$223 for the room and the balance for food. Cost of the room is \$222.92. He requested an advance check for the \$300 amount to pay cash for the room. Clinic dates are 1/28-1/30. Coach Barclay will provide Docia with receipts when he returns. The \$300 request was voted on and APPROVED.
- LeBrun Dugout – Docia met with Mr. Willis in December. The cost to build both dugouts is \$21,000. Money raised toward the dugouts to date is over \$11,000.00. Walt Regan is donating his time, and the materials are being donated. The final cost, after donations, will be \$6,000-\$8,000. The Board of Education was pleased and amazed with the fundraising effort. Docia still has more LeBrun t-shirts if anyone is interested.
- IRS Penalty – TAB received notice of a \$1200 fine because an IRS forms was not filled out properly. Docia asked the members in attendance, and all members receiving these Minutes, if anyone was interested in being the TAB accountant. Do we have a member or members that are Certified Public Accountants? Our Treasurer, Ron Allen, is not permitted to prepare and file the TAB taxes. TAB must have a CPA prepare and file them. Fortunately, the fine has been forgiven.

#### NEW BUSINESS

- Girls Track – Coach Ulrich requested money for 30 uniforms and warm ups. The warm-ups will stay with the school and not the girls. Track begins next week. The estimated cost for uniforms and warm-ups is \$6300.00 and could possibly be lower. They will send out donation letters as a fundraiser. Docia informed Coach Ulrich that they need to raise half of the cost or more before the order is placed. Money for uniforms and warm-ups, with the stipulation that half (or more) of the cost be raised by fundraising, was voted on and APPROVED.
- Varsity Baseball – supplies were ordered, e.g. cleat cleaner, etc. – cost was \$270.00. The items will arrive next week. Varsity baseball is not asking for anything else.
- Baseball, Basketball, and Girls Softball are together holding a golf tournament fundraiser.
- Girls Basketball – Maryanne reported that the team had a cheesecake fundraiser that profited \$600.00. PLEASE SEE MORE ABOUT THIS FUNDRAISING COMPANY IN THE NEXT BULLET ITEM....
- Spring Fundraising - The company used by the Girls Basketball team is Achieve Solutions, Inc., and also provides popcorn and cookie dough for fundraising. The representative, Angelo Di Norscia will be presenting at the next TAB meeting on February 24<sup>th</sup>. He would like to meet as many coaches as possible. Docia will send a memo to each coach regarding Mr. DiNorscia's presentation.
- TAB Fundraising – offering concessions at the “bigger” track meets (regionals, etc.) and at Boys Lacrosse games.
